In the days, weeks and months ahead, our resolve, our resourcefulness and our unity as a nation will be tested as never before.

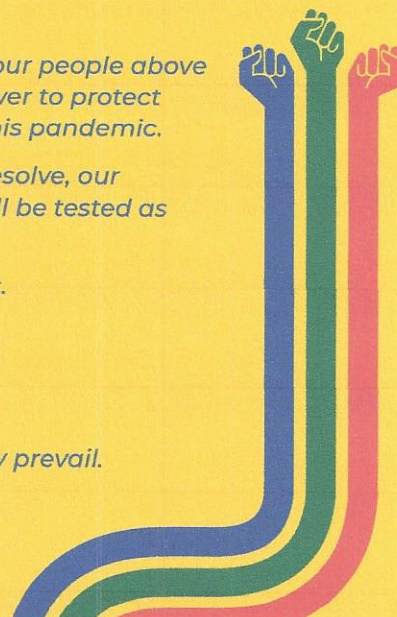
